



ANNUAL SHC HIGH POINT AWARDS

The High Point competition was started as an incentive to reward competitors for doing what they normally do during the show season.

Competitors can earn points from the following competitions for the high point:

- Agricultural Shows
- ESA Affiliated Shows
- SHC Affiliated Shows
- HOTY Shows, Grand National Qualifiers, Royal Shows, Grand Nationals and National level competition
- Breed classes / shows

High Point Sections

The high point is split up into city & country sections to reward competitors in both regions for their success during the show season. The sections are broken down below. You can enter more than one section (i.e. Led, Show Hack & Senior Rider) providing you are eligible for that section. Competitors can either enter as show hack or show hunter for the season they are in and gain points accordingly.

CITY SECTION (Adelaide Metro area) \$20.00 per section

SHC SA Reserves the right to combine sections of city and country if there are less than 3 competitors entered in that section.

High Point Score System

Different types of shows acquire different levels of points for wins and placings. This includes state level & National level wins, placings & Top 10. Competitors who enter the high point are being asked this season to regularly email their results following their shows to the High Point Coordinator email rbartalos@hotmail.com .

General Rules

- The High Point Performance year will be from **1st July to 1st May** each year
- **Results are to be returned as soon as possible to the 1st May each year for collation of results**
- Nomination fees will be **\$20.00** for each section entered
- Horses **CAN** be entered in more than one section (i.e. Show Hack, Rider & led)
- Horses can **ONLY** be a show hack or show hunter – SHC federal ruling – people need to nominate the section that they wish to compete in and stay in for 12 months (from 1/1/17 to 31/12/17)
- **PERFORMANCES WILL ONLY COUNT FROM WHEN COMPETITORS JOIN THE HIGH POINT COMPETITION – NO BACKDATING OF PERFORMANCE – SO JOIN UP EARLY TO NOT MISS OUT**
- Results need to be emailed regularly to the High Point Coordinator so that an ongoing record of your performances is kept with the High Point Coordinator. Email to send results to is rbartalos@hotmail.com
- Performance goes with the horse so if the horse entered in the section is sold performance will transfer to the new owner. If horses are sold and transfer from a country to city section with change of owners they will change sections in the high point also. Please contact the High Point Coordinator for any queries you might have.
- **Points can only be gained from 2 qualifying classes under saddle as for normal hack shows but does not affect Champion/Reserve and Supreme Awards.**
- **The same spirit of fair play applies to gaining only 1 win at Agricultural / 2 wins at SHC and other affiliated qualifying shows as usual. This rule does not apply to breed shows or Championship Shows or Royal Shows, where you may have more than 2 classes to compete in.**
- In the event of a tie at the end of the season we will do a count back and the person with the most SHC SA wins will be deemed the winner – so that there is a clear winner on each section.
- Sections are split into City and Country (over 150km out of Adelaide CBD) sections to allow for those competitors who have limited shows to attend. Please indicate section on nomination.

High Point Section Prizes (For all sections)

These prizes will be allocated to the classes providing we have at least 6 entries in the sections. In sections with less than 4 horses only the winner will receive a rug. Allocation of a sponsor's prize is subject to all sections being sponsored.
