## Rules and regulations for OTT Thoroughbred SHC SA Event

This event is open to all thoroughbreds that have officially raced or trialled either locally, nationally or internationally. All horses are required to be 4 years and over 14.2hh. All horses will be registered with RISA. (Racing Information Service Regulations)

Racing name to be used. When entering a Retired Racehorse Series event, if the horses name is different to their racing name or if the horse never raced but officially trialled please provide the following details.

- Racing name and Show name, brands, colour and markings
- Sire and dam
- And one of the following: Microchip number, Life number or Registration Certificate Number

This class will be judged as a combination of ridden and led. Fashion classes are led only.

Riders to be 14 years and over on the day of qualifying show.

Horses will be judged as a good example of a Thoroughbred rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration.

- Thoroughbred qualities
- Conformation
- Manners, paces and performance (workouts will include a gallop)
- Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
- Judge's decision is final

Stewards and judges' directions must be obeyed at all times. Failure to follow or abide by judges or stewards directions will be regarded as conduct unbecoming.

Conduct unbecoming will not be tolerated and will result in exclusion from competition as instructed by the steward/judge/coordinator.

Horses may be shown in natural state, ears, eyes, muzzle, legs and tail not clipped or pulled.

The use of coat dyes on horses are not be permitted.
