While the fires were still raging many of our members raced to help those in need, evacuating horses, collecting and coordinating donations, offering paddocks/stables and doing whatever else they could. A group even travelled to the York Peninsular to collect hay that had been kindly donated by Sue Stuart and then spent the day delivering it to those affected in Hamley Bridge and surrounding areas.

We are also very thankful to the support received from our friends interstate. Our Victorian friends led by Bev Richards and Sarah Berry raised over \$500 towards vet bills and sent a truck load of secondhand items for those affected. While SHC QLD donated \$100 towards our fire fund.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all those that 'stepped up' and continue to do so, as I know there are many out there still looking after animals, friends and even complete strangers. What a great bunch of people you are! A special thanks goes to Denise Fenwick and her group of volunteers that continue to help those in need and all the individuals and businesses that donated 'huge' amounts of horse and personal item for her to distribute where needed.

Denise held a 'Fire Relief Garage Sale' last Saturday, 19<sup>th</sup> December of some of the surplus items raising over \$1900. These funds will be equally divided between the Northern Vets for treatment of the fire affected animals at their practices. These vets have done an amazing service, often free of charge, so please support those that support us.

There have been so many people that have given either funds, time or goods and unfortunately we can't name them all so if you are one of them please feel personally thanked.

The SHC SA Affiliated Show held at Morphett Vale on December 20 was also held as a fundraiser for the Pinery Fires raising \$650. Thank you to those that ventured out in the not so pleasant weather conditions to show your support and a specials thanks to the Morphett Vale Riding Club for donating the grounds hire back to the cause. The amazing raffle that was organized for the show has so far raised \$230. We have been lucky enough to have over \$1500 worth of great prizes kindly donated, so the raffle will stay 'alive' until 'Rising Star' to allow anyone else that has missed out on the opportunity to buy a ticket for this great cause to grab one. 
